they could not catch him.





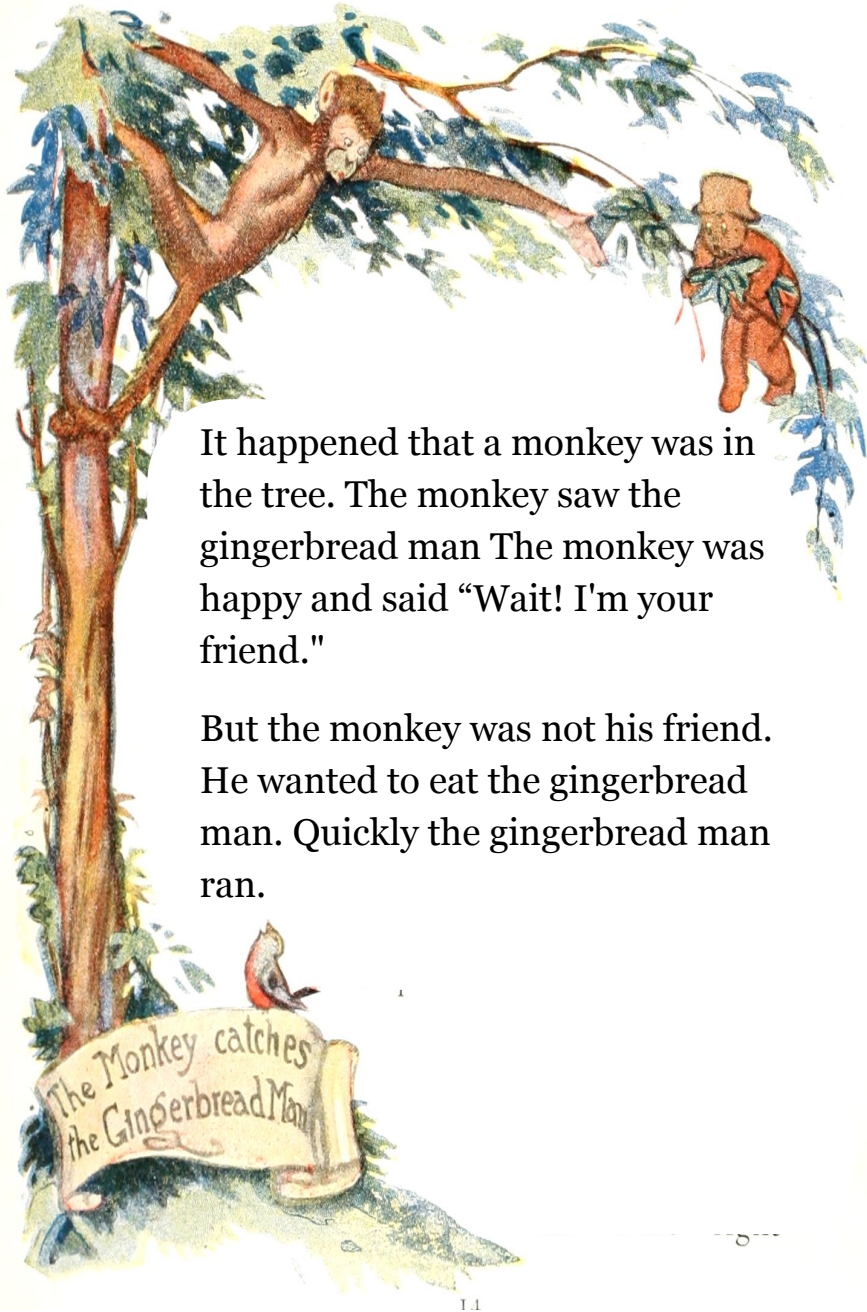
Soon the gingerbread man saw a tree.
