Everyone consulted the king and the queen. People would present the couple with difficult problems. They gave wise solutions. The king was just. The queen was compassionate.


The king and queen lived happily together for many years. There was only one problem: the couple wanted a baby, but they could not have a child.

Nine months later, the frog's prediction came true. The queen gave birth to a baby girl. The king and queen were happy parents. Everyone was very happy for the royal couple.


There was a very big celebration. Everyone was invited. The musicians played joyful music. Everyone was dancing with joy.
