Alice was so curious. So she got up and ran after the rabbit. The rabbit ran even faster.


Then, the rabbit jumped into a burrow.

After a minute, Alice saw a little house. On the door, it said: *Mister Rabbit*. It was the rabbit's house. Alice was very curious, so she went into the house.




Then, Alice saw a table. On the table, there was an object. It was a small bottle. On the bottle, it said, "DRINK ME."

"Yes, yes, you will grow very big," he said.


"Ah, perfect! I hate being small. I'm 3 centimeters tall and it's terrible," said Alice.
